

Job Title: Rink Operations Technician II

Under the supervision of the Director of Facilities Operations, this position contributes to the maintenance of the ice rinks and the facility with a focus on maintaining the ice surface quality and depth.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Measure ice and resurface rinks to maintain proper ice depths on all surfaces
- Maintaining accurate logs.
- Ability to operate ice resurfacer and other ice equipment.
- Ability to operate forklift, scissor lift, and other machinery.
- Responsible for setting up and taking down for all ice programming including nets, dividers, etc.
- Perform general labor associated with setup and break down of special events, ice removal/install, glass and board maintenance, etc.
- Service facility equipment both related and unrelated to ice
- Ability to operate power tools both mounted and handheld.
- Sweeping/cleaning/general maintenance of rink area including benches and locker rooms.
- Work professionally with other departments to ensure all building programs transition smoothly and run-on schedule.
- Evaluate the condition of ice resurfacers, compressors, HVAC system and other ice equipment and report issues and/or need for maintenance to director.
- Ensure that all maintenance activities are executed as requested and in a safe and professional manner.
- Inspect all areas of the building including common areas, bathrooms, locker rooms, meeting rooms, and building exterior for damage and repair or report to director.
- Foster a customer focused culture for both internal and external customers.
- Maintain a safe work environment in accordance with local, state, federal and OSHA guidelines.
- Other projects as assigned by the department director.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE AND ESSENTIAL SKILLS

- Certified Ice Technician. (Preferred but not required.)
- Ability to operate ice resurfacer and ice equipment.
- Understanding of HVAC, A/V and Ice making compressor systems. (Preferred but not required)
- Must possess mechanical skills.
- Excellent interpersonal, communication and organizational skills.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Must be a proactive, team player with excellent interpersonal skills.

- Must be able to communicate professionally and effectively with team members, management, and customers.
- Must have the availability to work mornings, days, nights, weekends, and holidays.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Must be able to work in a range of motion including but not limited to standing, sitting, overhead reaching, stooping, bending, crouching, kneeling, laying down.
- Must be able to lift items weighing 50+ lbs.
